Sample Itinerary

Day One

Board the bus for North Carolina. A lunch stop will be made while en route (on own) Check into your overnight accommodations at the Village Inn in Clemmons, NC. After check-in you will have a complimentary drink in the lounge before having dinner. (included)

Day Two

A breakfast buffet is included this morning. At 9:30 am, board the bus for a morning visit to Reynolda House Museum of American Art, built by R. J. Reynolds in 1914-1917 on a 1,067 acre estate. This 64 room country house offers a fine collection of furnishings and 18th, 19th, and 20th century American paintings, prints and sculptures by artists such as Mary Cassatt, Thomas Eakins, and Andrew Wyeth. Lunch is on your own. Board the bus to continue to Asheville to check into the Hampton Inn. Board the bus at 5:30 for an evening at the beautiful Grove Park Inn. Dinner, a wonderful buffet, will be at 6:00. After dinner you will have a chance to relax and enjoy the resort before departing at 9:30 pm to return to your hotel.

Day Three

After a continental breakfast, board the bus at 9:30 am for a day of touring the Asheville area. Your step on guide will take you on a wonderful tour of Asheville. At 3:30 you will return to the hotel to relax before boarding the bus at 5:30 pm for dinner at the Frankie Bones Restaurant.

Day Four

After a continental breakfast, board the bus at 9:30 am to visit the Biltmore Estate elaborately decorated for the holidays, including a majestic 35ft tree in the banquet hall with hundreds of wreaths and poinsettias and miles of evergreen roping. A shuttle bus will be available to visit the Biltmore Estate Winery for a self guided tour and wine tasting with an opportunity to purchase their wines. At 3:30 pm say good-bye to Asheville and continue to your overnight accommodations at the Comfort Suites in Johnson City, TN. Dinner tonight is at the Golden Corral at 5:30 pm. After dinner you will drive through a holiday light show at the Bristol Motor Speedway.

Day Five

Enjoy a deluxe continental breakfast before boarding the bus at 8:00 am for your journey home with fond memories of your Asheville Christmas vacation! A lunch stop will be made en route.
